



## ARMY INTER UNIT TEAM CHAMPIONSHIPS 2019

LONGMOOR TRAINING AREA  
WED 15 & THU 16 MAY 19



### FINAL ADMIN DETAILS

1. **General.** Planning for the Army Inter Unit Orienteering Championships 2019 is almost complete. The maps have been planned and will be printed this week. Most entries have been received, but there is still a trickle of last-minute interest.
2. **Aim.** The preliminary details published on the BAOC website remain extant. The aim of this document is to provide final administrative details that were not provided in the initial instruction.
3. **Event Flyer.** The event flyer is now available on the BAOC website and it provides the usual information, including approximate course lengths.
4. **Event Location.** The venue for both days is Longmoor Training Area, near Bordon. However, access to the Training Area on each day will be in two separate locations (see map at Annex A):
  - a. **Day 1.** Access is off the A325 between Bordon and Longmoor. From Bordon follow the signs for Longmoor Training Camp and turn onto the Training Area just before the A3. From the A3 (north or South) exit at the Bordon junction, heading towards Bordon on the A325. Turn onto the Training Area shortly after leaving the A3. The nearest postcode is GU33 6EL. Orienteering signs will direct you onto the Training Area and then the parking area.
  - b. **Day 2.** From the A325 south of Bordon, follow the signs through the village of Greatham. Once through the village, turn left onto Forest Road (signed Liss Forest), travel over the A3 and entry to the Training Area is approximately 1km further along Forest Road. The nearest postcode is GU33 7RA.
5. **Mapping.** The map scale is 1:10,000 and 5 Colour and will be overprinted on waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions will not be available but will be printed on the map.
6. **Dress.** All competitors must have full-leg cover and a T-Shirt as a minimum (i.e. no shorts or vests).
7. **Event Facilities.** Tom's Catering van will be providing refreshments (Wednesday only), please support them. Water will also be provided. Portaloos have been booked for both days.
8. **Demonstration Course.** A short Demonstration Course will be available close to the assembly area between 1030-1230 hrs on Day 1 only.
9. **Entry Fees.** Those units that have yet to pay their entry fees and EMIT Hire are to ensure that this is completed at Registration on Day 1.
10. **Day 1- Wed 15 May 19.** Day 1 will use the Spanish Score format. The details for Day 1 are as follows:
  - a. **Registration.** Registration will be open from 1030-1230 hrs. Team Captains are to collect a Registration Pack from the registration area to confirm their Day 1 entries and declare which runner is completing which course.
  - b. **Entry on the Day (EOD).** EOD will be available for individual runners who can choose to complete any of the available Spanish Score courses (Long, Medium or Short). EOD will

be £6.00 per person. EMIT Card hire, if required, will be an additional £1.50. EOD will be subject to map availability.

c. **Competitors' Brief.** For all teams participating in the Championships, a centralised Competitors' Brief will take place at the Assembly Area at 1245 hrs.

d. **Start Times.** Category start times are as follows:

- (1) EOD - 1100-1245 hrs.
- (2) Open - 1300 hrs.
- (3) Masters - 1305 hrs.
- (4) Women - 1310 hrs.
- (5) U25 - 1315 hrs.
- (6) Guest - 1320 hrs.

d. **Course closure.** Courses will close at 1500 hrs, or once all competitors have downloaded, whichever occurs first. All runners must download, even if they do not finish the course.

11. **Day 2 – Thu 16 May 19.** Day 2 will use the Harris format. Details are as follows:

a. **Registration.** Team Captains are to check and confirm their Relay Team Declarations and hand them in to the Registration Area before departing the Day 1 event. Registration will be open on Thu 16 May 19 from 0900 hrs.

b. **Entry on the Day (EOD).** EOD will be available for individual runners to participate in a 1-hour score event. EOD will be £6.00 per person. EMIT Card hire, if required, will be an additional £1.50. EOD will be subject to map availability.

c. **Competitors' Brief.** For all teams participating in the Championships, a centralised Competitors' Brief will take place at the Assembly Area at 1015 hrs.

d. **Start Times.** Category start times are as follows:

- (1) EOD - 0930-1020 hrs.
- (2) Open - 1030 hrs.
- (3) Masters - 1035 hrs.
- (4) Women - 1040 hrs.
- (5) U25 - 1045 hrs.
- (6) Guest - 1050 hrs.

e. **Course Closure.** The course will close at 1245 hrs, or once all competitors have downloaded, whichever is earliest. All runners must download, even if they do not finish the course.

12. **Prize Giving.** Prize Giving will take place at approximately 1300 hrs on Thu 16 May 19. All competitors are expected to remain for prize giving.

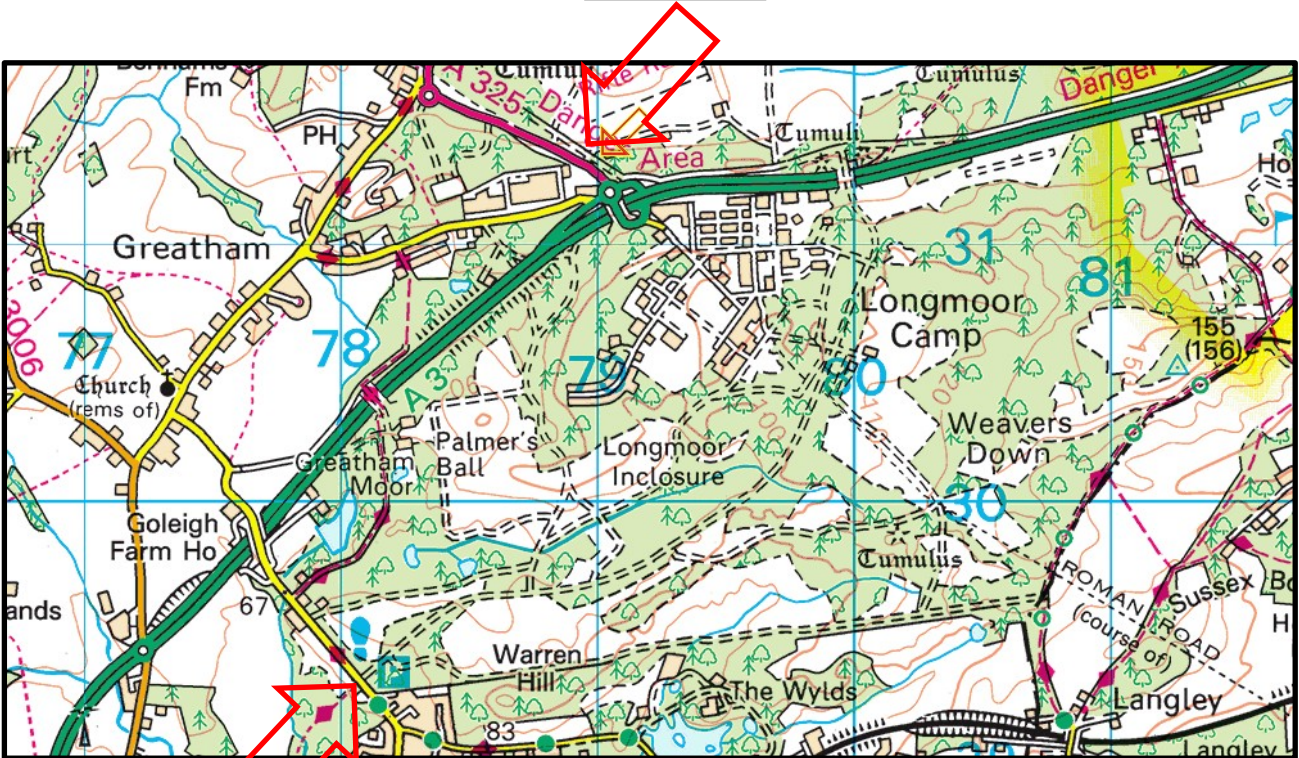
13. **Return of Trophies.** If you are the holders of a trophy from last year and haven't returned it yet, please ensure that you bring it with you (polished and engraved) and hand it in at Registration on Day 1.

14. **Accommodation.** For those units that have requested accommodation, it will be available at Longmoor Trg Camp. The following details apply:

- a. **Address.** Longmoor Training Camp

- b. **Reception.** Teams are to report to the guardroom following arrival at the main gate, where details of accommodation allocation will be provided.
- c. **Rooms.** All rooms are of a transit nature. Individuals should bring a sleeping bag. Team Captains are to ensure that rooms are swept clean and bins emptied before departing Longmoor.
- d. **Catering.** Cutlery will not be provided. Meal timings are as follows:
  - (1) **Evening meal – Wed 15 May** – 1700-1800 hrs.
  - (2) **Breakfast – Thu 16 May** – 0600-0800 hrs.
  - (3) **Packed Lunches – Thu 16 May 19.** Packed lunches have been booked for those that have requested accommodation at Longmoor only. Collection arrangements will be confirmed at the Competitors' Brief on Wed 15 May 19.
