- Travel:** Hawley Lake. Map Sheet 186. Parking at SU844 585. Signed from junction A327 Minley Road, Grid SU 830 574. Nearest Postcode GU17 9UD. Follow A327 north from M3 Junction 4a and follow the turning to Hawley Lake. New road on training area is still 10MPH. Runners crossing.
- Terrain:** Military training area, undulating terrain with a mix of vegetation, good network of tracks and areas with contour detail. Undergrowth growing fast.
- Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours, area mapped in 2019. All courses will be printed on A4 waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions for Blue & Green courses only.
- Results System:** EMIT– Results available on spread sheet at <http://baoc.info>
- Registration:** 1030 – 1355 hours
- Starts:** 1035 – 1400 hours
- Prize Giving:** 1200hrs
- Score Mass Start:** 10 mins after Prize Giving is completed 1300hrs latest
- Course Closes:** 1415 hours Controls will be taken in at 1415hrs
