

EXPORTING COURSE DETAILS FROM OCAD

Note: For a Level A or B Event, take care that the courses are numbered so that they match the event file setup. Generally it is best to follow the numbering scheme in the British Orienteering Guideline for these Events.

In OCAD 9

Note: Courses must be set up using OCAD's Course Setting Project feature

1) Choose menu item **COURSE > EXPORT > COURSES VERSION 8 (TEXT)**

Note - make sure you select the Version 8 option!

2) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and click on Save to create the course export file. By default the file will be saved in the same folder as the Ocad map file.

In OCAD 8

Note: Courses must be set up using OCAD's Course Setting Project feature

1) Choose menu item **FILE > EXPORT COURSES**

2) In the Export Courses dialog box, ensure Courses is selected and then click on OK.

3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and click on Save to create the course export file. By default the file will be saved in the same folder as the Ocad map file.

EXPORTING COURSE DETAILS FROM CONDES

IN CONDES 8:

1) Choose menu item **EXPORT > EXPORT EVENT DATA > IOF XML FORMAT**

2) All courses available should be ticked, File Type should be IOF Version 2.0; Remove the tick from 'Omit "CourseIDs"'. Click on the EXPORT button.

3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and save the file as a XML file.

IN CONDES 7:

1) Choose menu item **FILE > EXPORT DATA > CLASSIC FORMAT**

2) All courses available should be ticked, File Type should be IOF Version 2.0. Click on the EXPORT button.

3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and save the file as a DAT file.

EXPORTING COURSE DETAILS FROM PURPLE PEN

- 1) First get the courses in order by using **COURSE > COURSE ORDER** and moving the courses up or down as necessary.
- 2) Choose menu item **FILE > CREATE E-PUNCH INTERCHANGE FILE**.
- 3) Enter a filename (or accept the suggested name) and save the file as a XML file.
