- Terrain: Fast runnable forest with some open heath, good network of tracks. There has been a number of areas which have had the trees thinned and the brashlings left of the ground.
- Mapping: Fully updated in 2014 by RLM Maps for the Compass Sport Cup Final. Scale 1:10,000 overprinted on A5 waterproof paper. Loose control description will be provided at registration
