MLN Prizegiving Score
At Hardwick Park
on Wed 28 Jun 17



- Location:** Hardwick Park is situated to the West of Sedgefield. The route to the park is signed with the brown road signs from the junction of the A689 and A177. Enter the park and follow through to the west most car park. Parking needs to be paid for at the ticket machine.
- Terrain:** The park is split by the A177 and the eastern area is fast sheep cropped grass segmented by fences into large fields. The western part is dominated by two large lakes and contains a mixture of woods and open spaces; there is a prominent path network in this part of the park
- Courses:** Mass start 60 min Odds and Evens score. All competitors must choose to start with EITHER odd numbered controls or even ones. At some point most competitors will swap over to odd or even numbered controls to collect as many of them as possible. It is not compulsory to visit all odd or even controls before swapping. All points have 10 points. A penalty of 1 point for every six seconds will be applied over 60 mins.
- Map:** 1: 5,000 scale. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.
- Punching system:** EMIT Touch Free Professional system. Emitags are available for loan at registration. Lost Emitags charged at £50
- Registration:** 12:00 – 13:00. Pre-registration is required for MLN events. Online Registration: open until 11am on the Tue before: www.clok.org.uk/cgi-bin/MLN_entry_01.pl
- Starts:** Mass start at 13:00. Course closes at 14:15.
- Start/finish:** <500m from registration
- Fees:** Military: £3, Civilian £5
- Facilities:** First Aid at registration. There are toilets and a cafe in the visitor centre
