<b>Terrain</b>	Penn Wood is one of the largest ancient woodlands in the Chilterns. Common Wood is semi-natural ancient woodland. Penn Wood is generally flat whilst Common Wood is gently sloping. Both woods are very varied with a mixture of conifer, beech and oak, and some open areas. There are many pits / depressions as a result of ancient clay and flint workings. The area was previously used for the Chiltern Challenge in 2015.
<b>Location</b>	At Penn Street, which is just off the A404 between High Wycombe and Amersham. Penn Street is signposted at SU924965, HP7 0QW.
<b>Parking</b>	At commercial premises at SU923956, adjacent to the Hit or Miss pub, Penn Street, HP7 0PX. Parking is limited, so please share transport.
