- Travel Directions:** Map Sheet 186, Grid SU829555. Signed south off the A3013 Fleet Road, nearest post code GU51 2RT. Single tracked road in and out.
- Terrain:** The area is flat mixed woodland area with rough open areas and a good network of tracks and a wide variety of terrain. Bracken is high but passable.
- Mapping:** A4 map, Scale 10,000. Remapped by RLMaps in Aug 2017 to ISOM 2017. Courses are over printed on waterproof paper with IOF on map. Loose control description will be provided at registration. Text description for the Lg Orange.

- Registration:** 1030 – 1355 hours
- Starts:** 1035 – 1400 hours
- Course Closes:** 1500 hours Controls will be taken in from 1500hrs
