Event:	This event is based in Ellington Banks training area, 2km to the North West of Ripon.
Location:	The entrance to the training area car park and registration is at GR SE281738 on the south side of the Ripon / Kikby Malzeard Road. Postcode HG4 3JZ.
Terrain:	Ellington banks training area contains a good selection of clearly defined tracks and narrow rides. The area is dominated by a central high feature as you enter the training area. It consists of rough open land to the East, difficult run / walk wood in the central area and runnable wood to the North, West and South. There are various areas of slow run undergrowth.
Courses:	Blue: 7.6Km, 32 controls and 165m climb. Lt Green: 4.3Km, 20 controls and 75m climb. Red: 4.9Km, 18 controls and 115m climb.
Map:	The map has been updated specifically for this event. 7,500 scale. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper. Loose descriptions in start lanes.
Punching system:	EMIT Emitag punching system. Ecards are available for loan at registration. Lost Ecards charged at £55
