Travel Directions: Moors Valley Country Park. Grid Reference SU124064
Access is from the B3081 Ringwood to Verwood Road.
Follow orienteering signs leading off the B3081 Ringwood to Verwood Road
Do not go to the main entrance to Moors Valley Country Park.

Terrain: A working coniferous forest with many recreational facilities. There are numerous forest roads and paths. Much of the area has deep furrows covered with long grass and lines of brashings, slowing progress.

Mapping: Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour. Map recently updated. Overprinted waterproof map with control description included. Loose control descriptions in start lanes.
