Terrain: Military trg area, fast, runnable, undulating / hilly open terrain interspersed with wood blocks. Good network of tracks and areas of contour detail.

Mapping: Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours, area mapped in Jan 17. All courses will be printed on A4 waterproof paper, loose control descriptions available at registration.

B	Blue	6.4 km	130 m	Experienced orienteers only
C	Light Green	4.9 km	90 m	Experienced orienteers only
D	Long Orange	5.5 km	90 m	Suitable for novices

All course distances and climb are subject to final controlling
(The RN & RM Champs will be run on the Blue course)
