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| Event Centre: | The Event Centre with ample parking will be located on the old 'Airfield' of Longmoor Training Area. Entry to the area will ONLY be accessed via the Griggs Green Range Gate at: Post Code GU30 7PG, Grid SU81703190 or Sat Nav 51.080438 -0.834663. The gate is located at the next junction on from the Longmoor junction, approx. 1.5 miles north towards Guildford on the A3. The gate can be accessed from both the north and south bound carriageways. The Gate will only be open from 11.00 to 15.00 hrs |
| Terrain: | Military Training Area, Fast, Runnable, Undulating, Hilly, Open terrain interspersed with wooded areas. Good network of tracks and areas of complex contour detail. |
| Mapping: | Mapped by RLM Maps April 2017 - Scale: 1:7,500. 5m contours. All Courses are printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control Descriptions on map, loose text controls will be available at registration. |
| Course: | 1 hour Score event – 25 Controls values 10, 20 & 30 points, plus 3 novelty 'mobile' Christmas bonus controls when added together are worth an extra 100 points. 1 Point penalty for every 6 seconds over the 1 hour time limit. |
| Timings: | <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Registration: 11.30 to 12.30 hrs.2. Mini mass starts at: 12.00, 12.30 and 13:00 hrs.3. Course close: 14.30 hrs after which controls will be collected.4. All runners must download by course closure time. |
