- Terrain:** Very runnable open forest, many tracks and ditches, small areas of undergrowth.
- Mapping:** Minor Updates in 2017. Scale 1:10,000 overprinted on waterproof paper. A4.

- Registration:** MLS registration open from 1100 to 1400
- Starts:** Starts from 1115 to 1415
