- Travel Directions:** Perham Down, Ludgershall. Signed nearest postcode SP11 9FQ. Entry point next to Poppies Nursery.
- Parking:** Old range point, grassed area marked by guides.
- Terrain:** Series of interlinked ridge lines with a variation of dense scrub, open grassland and mature, mixed forest. Areas of forest vary in going from open runnable to slow-going with thick undergrowth. Tracks are prevalent in the forest areas and runners should be aware of unmarked motorbike trails. A steep escarpment runs north to south along the western boundary.
- Mapping:** A4 Map: Scale 1:10,000. Updated in early 2018 by Alan Kersley and Eric Male and upgraded to ISOM2017 symbols with 300m interval magnetic north lines. Overprinted on waterproof paper.

- Registration:** 1100 – 1400 hours
- Starts:** 1115 – 1415 hours. Loose control descriptions available at Registration.
- Course Closes:** 1515 hours, controls will be taken in from 1515 hrs.
