Travel Directions: Parking at SU855334 on a cut grass pitch. Signed of the East bound part of the A3 at Grid SU856330. **This is a fast moving dual carriageway; please signal early.** The nearest post code is GU30 7QZ. Take care when driving from the barrier to the car park, runners crossing in both directions.

Terrain: The area is undulating with mixed woodland area, rough open and a good network of tracks with a wide variety of terrain. Bracken is largely dead and passable; new growth beginning to show.

Mapping: A4 map, Scale 10,000. Remapped by RLMaps in Spring 2017 and converted to ISOM 2017. Courses are over printed on waterproof paper with IOF on map. Loose control description will be provided at registration. Text description for the Red Course.
