- Travel Directions.** Grid SU799371, nearest postcode GU35 ONF. The entrance to the area is off the A325 from the South 300m North the New Roundabout as you leave Bordon. From the north turn right off A325 just past the “Flaming Tucker” burger wagon (in lay by on left). The event will be signed off the A325.
- Terrain:** The terrain is gently undulating and is generally a mixture of fast runnable woods and open fields. There is some gorse on the northern common part. The River that runs East – West **IS ONLY TO BE CROSSED USING THE BRIDGES SHOWN on the map.** The Brown and Blue courses cross the A325 with timed crossings.
- Map:** The map is 1:10000 updated Mar 18. All courses are single sided and over printed on waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions at registration.
- Registration:** Reg Open 1100 -1430 hrs Starts 1115 – 1445 hrs Course Closes: 1600 hrs
- Other:** Units wishing to bring more than 10 personnel are requested to contact the Organiser in advance

Brown Course 10.2 km, experienced orienteers only (2 timed road crossings)
Blue Course 8.4 km, experienced orienteers only (2 timed road crossings)
Light Green Course 4.8 km, experienced and progressing orienteers only
Red Course 5.4 km Suitable for Novices
