- Travel Directions:** Map Sheet 186, Grid SU828492 nearest Post Code GU105AB. Parking is on tracks and clearings.
- Terrain:** Fast runnable undulating open forest, intricate terrain and good network of tracks.
- Mapping:** Last updated in 2013 with minor updates for this event. ISOM 2017. Scale 1:7,500 overprinted on A4 waterproof paper. Loose control description for Blue, Green and Short Green course at registration.
- Results System:** EMIT– Results provided by the EMIT Team <http://baoc.info>
- Registration:** 1100 – 1400 hours
- Starts:** 1105 – 1400 hours. Mass start Score at 1330 after Prize Giving.
- Prize Giving:** 1230hrs Mass Score start at 1330hrs. Recommend you come ready to race.
- Course Closes:** 1500 hours

All runners must download by course closure time; even if you do not finish the course.

The Score challenge will be how many people can get all 40 controls.
