- Terrain:** Fast runnable undulating open forest, intricate terrain and good network of tracks.
- Mapping:** Last updated in 2013 with minor updates for this event. ISOM 2017. Scale 1:7,500 overprinted on waterproof paper. Loose control description for Blue, Green and Short Green course at registration.
- Results System:** EMIT– Results provided by the EMIT Team <http://baoc.info>
- Prize Giving:** TBC
- Registration:** 1100 – 1400 hours
- Starts:** 1105 – 1430 hours Line course (Score Mass start after Prize Giving)
