Location:

Hogmoor Inclosure, was Trg Area K1. Gr SU786355, Post code GU35 9HL. Car park is off Hogmoor Rd at the back of what was Bordon Camp, but is now a new housing estate and Ind Park. From North turn right off A325 at lights and head west along B2002 towards Oakhangar, which becomes Oakhangar Rd. Then turn south onto Hogmoor Rd opposite the BOSC turning and travel 800m south. Coming from south off A3, use A325 and then turn left at new roundabout in Whitehill and then right after 500m onto Hogmoor Road.

Terrain:

This area was extensively used for armoured vehicle driver training, so lots of gullies & pits. It is a mix of woods & open sandy areas/tracks, with lots of re-entrants, earthbanks & ditches plus an extensive path network. Veg high in some places, but all tracks & sandy areas in the middle are runnable. Area is quite technical, TD4 (even 5 in places).
