Travel Directions: Map Sheet 175/186, Grid SU915562 nearest Post Code GU24 0BD from the B3012 only. Parking is on tracks and clearings.

Terrain: Intricate forested area with excellent contour details and good path network.

Mapping: A5 map, Scale 1:10,000. Updated for the SN Trophy in early Nov 14. Courses are over printed on waterproof paper with IOF on map. Loose control description will be provided at registration. Text description for the Score course

Results System: Pencil and paper. Results provided on Spread sheet Wed evening <http://baoc.info>

Registration: 1030 – 1400 hours

Starts: 1035 – 1400 hours (Note course closing longer courses)

Course Closes: 1500hrs

All runners must download by course closure time; even if you do not finish the course.

Hydration: all competitors must ensure they are fully hydrated before starting, there will be water at the start, twice during each course and at the end. Carry water, reduce your course length or walk with help to ensure you achieve your aim safely.
