- Travel Directions:** From the A30 in Camberley at Sheet 186, Grid [SU875608](#) (traffic light Jct with VW Garage and Romans Estate Agents) travel north up Kings Ride onto training area at Grid SU87556215 ([Google Maps](#) – [Multimap](#) – [Streetmap](#); Satnav: Lat: 51.351196N, Long: 0.744487W) and then follow signs to parking.
- Terrain:** Typical Surrey heathland with fast open forests with a few hills, areas of bracken going over, good network of tracks.
- Mapping:** Updated in 2015. Minor updates for this event. Scale 1:10,000 overprinted waterproof. Control descriptions on map and loose at registration.
- Results System:** EMIT - Results available at <http://www.baoc.info/>.
- Registration:** 1100 – 1400 hours
- Starts:** 1115 – 1415 hours
- Course Closes:** 1530 hours (Controls will be taken in from 1530hrs)
