**Travel Directions:** Hawley & Hornley, Nr Gibraltar Barracks Blackwater, Camberley. Map Sheet 186. Parking at SU844 585. Signed from junction A327 Minley Road, Grid SU 830 574. Nearest Postcode GU17 9UA (Crown and Cushion pub, A327 Old Minley Road). Follow A327 north from M3 Junction 4a and look for turning to Hawley Lake Sail Training Centre.

**Terrain:** Military training area, undulating terrain with a mix of vegetation, good network of tracks and areas with fine contour detail.

**Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours, area mapped in 2016. All courses will be printed on A4 waterproof paper with loose control descriptions available at Registration. Map Symbols are iaw ISOM 2017; Control Descriptions are iaw IOF 2018.
