Terrain: Steep chalk escarpment running north to south in the west covered in some wood blocks. Eastern part of the map large prominent re-entrants running east to west. Open range area with some wood blocks. Extensive track network.

Mapping: Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour. Map updated 2018 to ISOM 2017. Overprinted on waterproof paper. Control descriptions on map and loose descriptions available at Registration.
