- Terrain:** Typical Surrey heathland with fast open forests with a few hills, areas of bracken now low, good network of tracks.
- Mapping:** Updated in 2015. Minor updates for this event. Scale 1:10,000 overprinted waterproof. Loose control descriptions will be provided at registration.
- Results System:** EMIT - Results available at <http://www.baoc.info/>.
- Registration:** 1100 – 1400 hours
- Starts:** 1115 – 1415 hours
- Course Closes:** 1530 hours (Controls will be taken in from 1530hrs)
