Travel Directions:	Map Sheet 175/186, Grid SU915562 nearest Post Code GU24 0BD from the B3012 only. Parking is on tracks and clearings. Note this is a fast road.			
Terrain:	Intricate forested area with excellent contour details and good path network. A lot of forest thinning has taken place and has made visibility clearer but some brashling have been left on the ground. Bracken is present but easy passable and not shown on the map for ease of reading.			
Mapping:	A4 map, Scale 7,500. Courses are over printed on waterproof A4 paper with IOF/text descriptions on the map. Loose control description will be provided at registration.
