- Travel Directions:** Grid Ref: TL12354038. Nearest postcode is SG17 5QB. See attached map. From the West exit M1 at Junc 13 and follow A507 through Ampthill towards Shefford. From East exit A1M at Baldock Services head west through Stotfold and follow A507 to Shefford. Turn onto A600 and follow Forestry Commission signs for Rowney Warren, exit off the A600 down Sandy Lane into FC car park. Sandy Lane leads to the entrance to JFIG Chicksands.
- Terrain:** The area is wooded with some deep reentrants and lots of contour detail, no water features. The western 2/3rds of the map is used extensively for biking, so lots of minor tracks. 75% runnable, but vegetation is growing fast.
- Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000, 5 Colour. Map updated Jan 2019. Overprinted on waterproof paper. Loose control descriptions available at registration.
- Timing System:** EMIT Touch Free – Results available at <http://baoc/info>
- Registration:** Sapper Games starts 1000-1200hrs, MLC starts from 1300-1900hrs (Earlier if you pre-book a slot). Courses close 2000 hrs
