Travel Directions: Signed off the A342 at Trenchard Lines, Upavon. Grid Ref SU156547. Nearest Postcode is SN9 6BE. Entry point is the Upavon Airfield, opposite Trenchard Lines. Parking is on hard-standing by the hangars, with Registration located by the entry point.

Terrain: This is an Urban event within a typical military barracks and married quarter estate, with minimal climb throughout. **Runners should be wary of moving vehicles on the roadways within the mapped area.**

Mapping: Scale 1:3,500, 5 Colour. Last major map update was early 2016. Overprinted waterproof paper. **Control descriptions on map only.**
