Travel Directions: Signed off B3075, Morden Rd, Lawsons Clump Car Park, Enter the car park and follow the track through the barrier until met by a marshal and parked. Minibuses are to park in Lawsons Clump Car park if space is available. GR for Lawsons Clump SY921909. Nearest Postcode is BH20 7DB.

Terrain: An exciting opportunity to test your skill on an area that has not been utilised for more than 7 years due landowner permissions. The forest has changed significantly over the last decade and promises to offer challenges on unfamiliar ground. Gore Heath is a primarily a typical Dorset working forest with areas of intricate contours and rhododendrons. The area is interspersed with a significant main track network and winding MTB tracks that are prevalent in most forests today.
