



# Military League North #1 19-20 Kippax, Leeds on Wed 18 Sep 19



**Location** Directions to reception location: From M1 Junction 47 head towards Castleford on the A656, straight across first roundabout (A63) then at the next traffic lights turn right towards Kippax (B6137). At the mini roundabout in the centre of Kippax fork left onto Butt Hill and follow the road downhill past the Swimming Pool for 1.5k – Great Preston Sports and Social Club is on the left, 300 metres past the old railway bridge – park in their car park. Postcode - LS26 8AX

From A1 South: Exit A1(M) at Junction 42 – towards Leeds on the A63 – right at first roundabout, left at second roundabout – at third roundabout (junction with A656) turn left towards Castleford. Turn right at first traffic lights towards Kippax (B6137), then as above.

**Terrain:** Urban event - quite hilly with lots of 'snickets' (as we say in Yorkshire). Trail shoes recommended especially if wet weather is forecast. Some courses touch upon Billy Woods where some minor paths have not been mapped. Also, avoid damage to the low brushwood barriers they've put up in Billy Woods to direct members of the public along paths – This will affect future use of the area.

Most courses include a quite open Nature Reserve with a good path network.

	Lt Green	3.6Km, 60m, 19 controls
	Red	5.0Km, 30m, 13 controls

**Map:** 1:4K scale Blue & LG, 5K Red. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.

**Punching system:** EMIT touch free. Emitags are available for loan at registration. Lost Emitags charged at £50

**Starts:** 11:00 to 14:00. Courses close at 15:00.
