- Travel Directions:** Parking at SU855334 on a cut grass pitch. Signed of the East bound part of the A3 at Grid SU856330. This is a fast moving dual carriageway; please signal early nearest post code is GU30 7QZ. Take care when driving from the barrier to the car park, runners crossing in both directions.
- Terrain:** The area is undulating with mixed woodland area, rough open and a good network of tracks with a wide variety of terrain. Bracken is deep in places, especially southern rides.
- Mapping:** A4 map, Scale 10,000. Remapped by RLMaps in Spring 2017 and converted to ISOM 2017, updated summer 2019. Courses are over printed on waterproof paper with IOF on map.
