**Tweseldown & Brock's Hill + Long Valley North
Saturday 13th November 2021**

- Location:** Tweseldown Equestrian Centre (ex-Racecourse), Bourley Road, Church Crookham, Fleet. OS Map Sheet 186. Entrance to parking at SU 823517, Lat Long 51.258610, -0.820741, what3words 'stiletto.cats.barmaid'; postcode: GU52 8AD.
- Terrain:** Tweseldown Equestrian Centre, mostly fast open with some heathland; public access woods of all levels of runnability, intersected by many paths and rides and further heathland, some very marshy; part of the Long Valley military driver training area, just for the Blue Men course, with mature woodlands around the main tracks.
- Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000 for Blue Men; 1:7,500 all others. 5m contours. Full update based on survey Oct/Nov 2020. Printed on A4 waterproof paper by BML.

- Pre-Entry** **Open from Wed 13 Oct at <https://racesignup.co.uk/> Entries close Wed 10 Nov at 1200hrs. (Army competitors need to enter for the Inter Corps event and not the Southern Nights)**

- Dress:** Full leg and upper arm cover is mandatory; that means no shorts or vests.
- Safety Eqpt:** All competitors must carry a spare torch (head or hand) and whistle.
- Costs:** The cost per runner will be £24.00, £10.00 for the night event and £14.00 for the day event. This includes EMIT Tag hire.

- Data:** The personal data you give at Registration will be used by the event organisers and their agents but only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results, conducting safety checks and as required by our insurers to validate our cover; and managed iaw the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Insurance:** For civilians participating in Army orienteering, Public Liability Insurance is provided by Towergate; individuals are advised to have their own private accident insurance. This event is conducted iaw British Orienteering Rules 2020 (v3.9) and land booked iaw the AOA DIO Licence and JSP907. A detailed safety brief will be displayed at registration and in all start lanes; by passing through the start process you will be deemed to have read it.
- Car park:** Parking is situated on the racecourse hard standing opposite the Racecourse, sign posted off the Bourley Road. All drivers are to park as directed.
- Water:** There will be no water for refreshment, bring your own.

All runners must download – even if they don't finish the course!

Orienteering is an adventure sport and in the Army is classed as Individual Military Training. Competitors are responsible for their own personal safety and for assessing their own abilities to complete the course.
