Long Valley North
Sunday 14th November 2021



- Location:** Eelmoor Plain, Long Valley (North) Military Training Area. Between Aldershot and Fleet, Off Fleet Road, A323. OS Map Sheet 186. Entrance to parking at SU 847526, what3words 'lend, duty, apply'; Postcode, GU11 2HL
- Terrain:** Long Valley (North) military training area, variable runnability heathland and mature woodlands around significant vehicle tracks on hard surfaces, sand and through water splashes. Mostly flat, with two 15m hills used for driving training resulting in contour detail. Much gorse has been recently cleared.
- Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000. 5m contours. Full update based on survey Oct/Nov 2020. Printed on waterproof paper by BML.
- Punching:** SI- Results available at <http://baoc.info> **No SIAC touch free. Lost SI dibber cost £30.00**

- Registration:** 1000 hrs, Team Captains only to collect SI dibbers
- Starts:** 1030 hrs, Start/Finish within 2 min walk of assy area. **Cses Close:** 1500 hrs (controls in)
- Courses:** (Subject to final controlling)

- Safety Eqpt:** **All competitors must carry a whistle.** (Available for purchase (£1) at Registration).
- Dress:** Full leg and upper arm cover is mandatory; that means no shorts or vests.
- Costs:** The cost per runner will be £24.00, £14.00 for the night event and £10.00 for the day event.

- Data:** The personal data you give at Registration will be used by the event organisers and their agents but only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results, conducting safety checks and as required by our insurers to validate our cover; and managed iaw the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)
- Insurance** For civilians participating in Army orienteering, Public Liability Insurance is provided by Towergate; individuals are advised to have their own private accident insurance. This event is conducted iaw British Orienteering Rules 2020 (v3.9) and land booked iaw the AOA DIO Licence and JSP907. A detailed safety brief will be displayed at registration and in all start lanes; by passing through the start process you will be deemed to have read it.
- Water** There will be no water for refreshment, bring your own.

All runners must download – even if they don't finish the course!

Orienteering is an adventure sport and in the Army is classed as Individual Military Training. Competitors are responsible for their own personal safety and for assessing their own abilities to complete the course.
