Travel Directions: Approach Brockenhurst down A337 from Lyndhurst and turn left (East) onto B3055 at the Balmerlawn Hotel. Stay on B3055 for 3Km and then turn South into Roundhill Campsite (on OS map called (Lodge Heath)), GR SU328025. Address is New Forest Beaulieu Road, Brockenhurst SO42 7QL

Terrain: Example – Typical New Forest terrain with open forests, open areas, a good network of tracks & rides and many wet ditches/marshes. Only significant rootstocks mapped. Bracken dying back so direct routes runnable. Brown, Blue & MTBO cross B3055 approach road.
