- Travel Directions:** From North exit M27 Junc 1 at Cadnam onto B3079, turn left in Brook onto B3078 and then turn left after 2kms onto minor road signed to Fritham, ignore turning right to Fritham and follow O signs to Janesmoor Plain area. If coming from south exit A31 at Stoney Cross Plain turn off and drive 2kms to Janesmoor Plain area. If coming from West you can follow signs to Firtham along B3078 or B3080. Parking across road from Janesmoor pond, with overflow in Janesmoor Pond car park. Grid Ref for Pond is: SU 2466 1346 • X/Y co-ords: 424667, 113461 • Lat/Long: 50.92010117,-1.65045395
