<b>Travel Directions:</b>	HMS Sultan is a Naval Bks in Gosport, Hampshire and split in two by the Military Road, which runs (North to South). All courses are on just the West Site with entrance and exit at the Caledonian Gate, <b>W3W: "herb.join.prone"</b> , Post code: <b>PO12 3GB</b> . Please have your photo ID ready to be checked. The site is on the main a big one-way circuit.

<b>Terrain:</b>	Royal Navy Training Establishment is flat and made up of offices, classrooms, workshops, aircraft hangers, roads and Victorian Forts which have deep water moats.			
<b>Mapping:</b>	This is an urban event so the actual courses length may be 25-40% longer than the straight-line calculations. Map 1:5000 with minor corrections made Jul 22 for this event. Loose control description will be provided at the start. Maps printed on A3 waterproof paper.			
<b>Pre-entry:</b>	Open at 20:00 hrs on the 24 Aug at <a href="https://racesignup.co.uk">racesignup.co.uk</a> . <b>No Late EOD allowed as your name will not be on the entry list.</b>
