Travel Directions:	<p>Yoxter Cadet Training Camp is located near the Mendip Hills between the villages of Charterhouse and Priddy. The nearest post code is BA5 3BS. The entrance to the camp is at Grid ST 5109 5434. The What3words reference: last.mooring.enchanted.</p> <p>The entrance is on a busy B road so please be careful entering and exiting the camp as traffic routinely drives too fast.</p>			
Terrain:	<p>This is a rural event, no traffic. You will be running on undulating open ground with dispersed brush and small copses. Extensive mining has left deep depressions and gullies which provide the navigational challenge. There are stock fences and some, often indistinct, paths. Working farmland with cattle, horses and sheep. Please respect animals, shut gates and no dogs on the course.</p>			
Mapping:	<p>" The map is A4 printed on waterproof paper, scale 1:7500, contour interval 2.5m, last update 2017. Areas of scattered trees have not been mapped so appear as open. Since the update the many areas of gorse thickets (dark green) have spread typically by 15%. "</p> <p>Loose control description will be provided at the start.</p>
