Notes:

- Registration:** Those who need to collect a hire card should go to Registration, where you can also leave keys
- Car park** All drivers are to park as directed in lines with a gap between lines.
- Water** There will be no water for refreshment, bring your own.
- Disinfectant** Bring your own to wipe anything you may touch, toilet, car etc.
- Start** Punch on the Start Register control just before you enter start lane, this registers that you have started and also confirms your ecard is working as light on control should flash and if you have the latest V6 ecard the light on the ecard will also flash
- Start Clock** There will be a start clock in the start lane.
- On the Course** Watch out for ponies and other grazing animals, give them a wave and a smile.
- Finish** The Brown and Blue course finish across the road to the east and should follow the tape route back to download.
- Download** Ensure you are drip and spittle free before approaching download, place your card on the Reader, if you have a hire card you will be asked for your name then drop any hire cards in the bucket under the reader stand and take your printout off the printer.
