
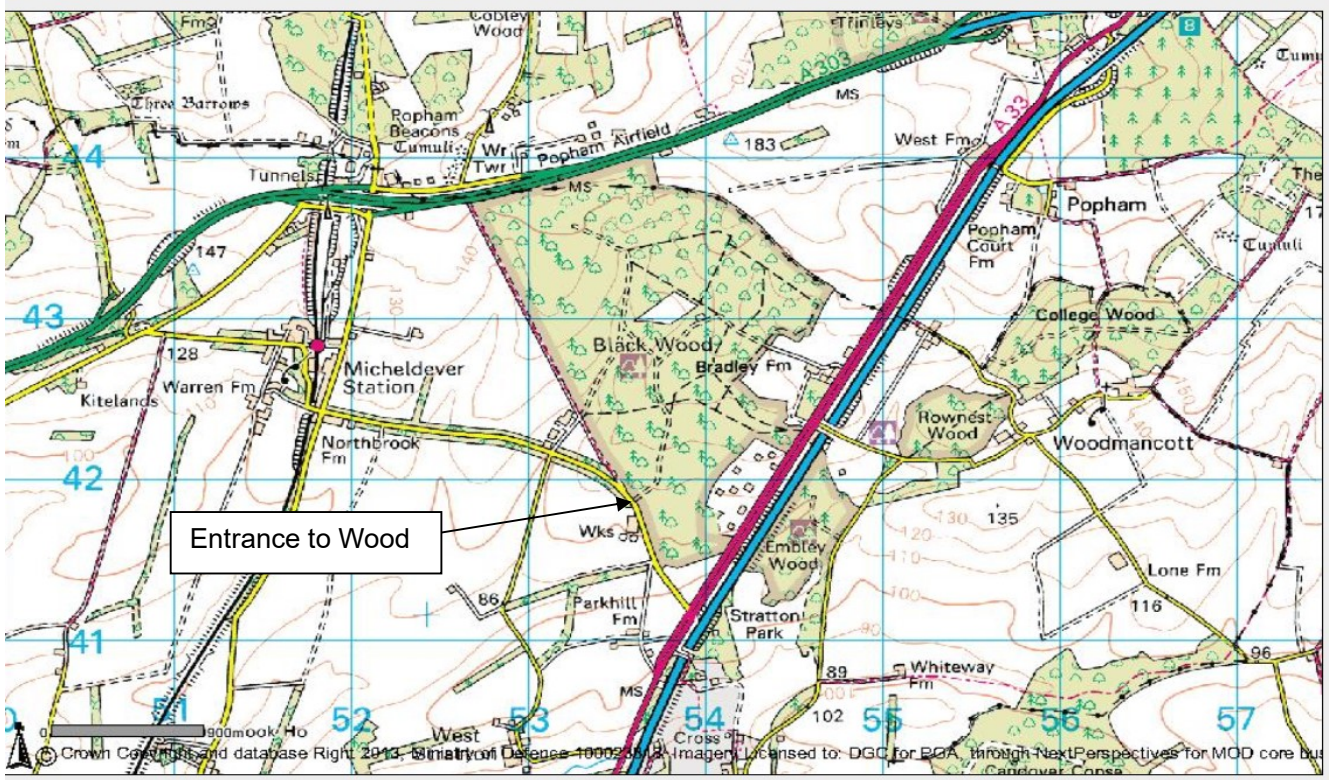
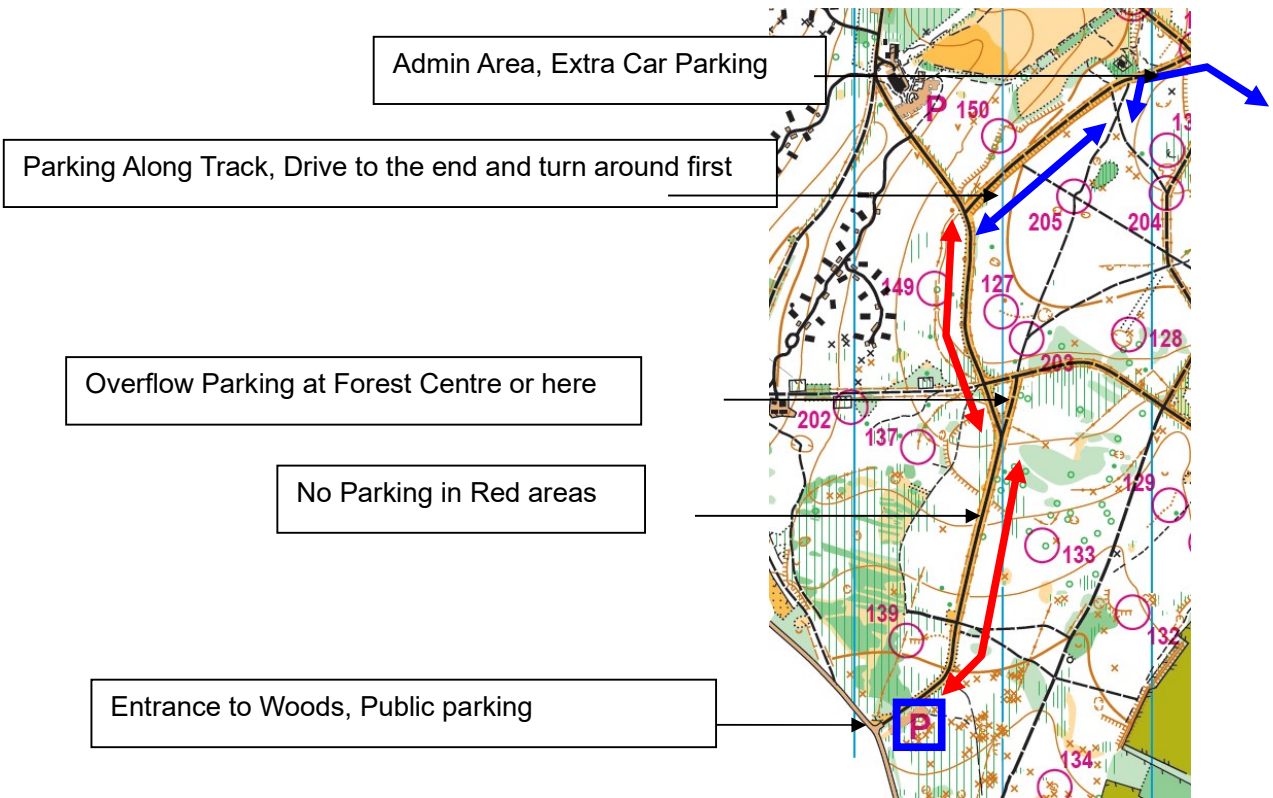

<b>Travel Directions:</b>	What3Words: <b>checked.stumble.parked</b> . takes you to the entrance to Blackwood off Larkwhistle Farm Road. Drive down dirt track towards Forest Holidays <b>(take care as competitors will be crossing the track at several points)</b> and turn right at <b>dolls.novels.helpers</b> and follow track to Regn. <b>M3 Southbound</b> exit at J7 and follow A33 towards Winchester. <b>M3 Northbound</b> exit at J9, take A34 keeping right and filter onto A33. <b>A303 eastbound</b> follow signs to Micheldever Station and continue East past the village. Forest entrance SU536418. Nearest postcode: SO21 3BG Forest Holiday Centre in Black Wood. Parking is on forest tracks -see map below				
<b>Terrain:</b>	Blackwood is a gently undulating forest with mostly deciduous trees. The woods are very open and terrain is fast, which favours those taking the direct route.				
<b>Mapping:</b>	Updated in Mar 2023 by Alan Kersley BADO. Scale 1:10,000 overprinted on waterproof paper. Loose control description provided at the start.
