Brunswick Camp, Range Complex & Bisley NRA
Saturday 25th November 2023

- Location:** Pirbright Camp, Brunswick Rd, Brookwood, GU24 0DT. OS Map Sheet 186. Entrance to parking at SU 933568, what3words 'tips.quench.hogs'. **Pre-booked access only via [racesignup](https://racesignup.co.uk/)**. No pedestrian or cycle access; please share transport where possible.
- Terrain:** Largely a new area for orienteering; woodland blocks with evidence of historic and current military training interspersed with open cropped grassland and range fixtures; some marshy areas with many ditches and paths. The NRA complex comprises buildings, static caravans, and open spaces. The area is fast underfoot with limited 1% climb on all courses.
- Mapping:** 1:5,000 ISprOM Surveyed 2023. Printed on A3 waterproof paper by BML.
- Results:** EMIT UK – Results available at <http://baoc.info>
- Pre-Entry** **No Late entry; no EOD.** Enter via <https://racesignup.co.uk/> **Entries close on Sun 19 Nov 23 at 2359 hours.** For security reasons, entry is open to British Orienteering members and MOD personnel only (*Army competitors must enter the Inter Corps, not the Southern Nights; see separate flyer; entry via Corps Team Captains*).

- Dress:** Full leg and upper arm cover is mandatory; no shorts or vests.
- Safety Eqpt:** All competitors must carry a spare torch (head or hand) and a whistle.
- Costs:** The cost per runner is £11.00 for the night event, Jnrs £7. EMIT card hire is £2.00
- Officials** **SRO:** Lt Col R Mawer AAC **Organiser:** Maj R Barrett RLC **Planner:** Mr Pete Jones SN **Controller:** Mr Steve McKinley SN, **Asst Organiser:** Allan Farrington
- Facilities:** **Indoor Assembly area;** Toilets, Caterer and Compasspoint. **Prize-giving.**
- Data:** The personal data you provide will be used by the event organisers and their agents but only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results, conducting safety checks and managed iaw the GDPR.
- Insurance:** Public Liability Insurance is provided via your BOF membership; individuals are advised to have their own private accident insurance. This event is conducted iaw British Orienteering Rules and land booked iaw the AOA DIO Licence and JSP907. A detailed safety brief will be displayed at registration and in all start lanes; by passing through the start process you will be deemed to have read it.
- Car park:** Parking at the Brunswick camp within Pirbright Camp; all drivers are to follow event signage. **Access:** Prebooked entry only via race signup; No pedestrian or cycle access. No EOD; BOF members and MOD personnel only with **picture ID (Driving licence or passport)**.

Orienteering is an adventure sport; in the Army it is classed as Individual Military Training. Competitors are responsible for their own personal safety and for assessing their abilities to complete the course.

All runners must download – even if they do not complete the course.
