Inter Corps and Individual Championships
And the SN Trophy
Mytchett & Congo Stream
Sunday 26th November 2023**



- Location:** E3 Trg Area Camping Ground (Congo Stream) nr Pirbright between Brookwood and Frimley Green; signed off Gapemouth Rd, B3012. OS Map Sheet 186 GR924563. Entrance to parking at what3words 'exporters.frostbite.mock', nearest Postcode GU24 0DN.
- Terrain:** Mytchett is a prime mil trg and an amazing orienteering area previously used for British Championships and World Cup races. Some sections have been used regularly for MLS events. The area consists of a mix of fast mature forest and some open heathland, overlaid with a complex mixture of paths with evidence of significant exercise usage. Defined contour slopes are complemented with smaller intricate contour detail. A timed-out road crossing will connect Mytchett with Congo stream; all courses will benefit from a spectator finish run-in.
- Mapping:** Scale 1:10,000, 5m contours. Updated map based on a lidar survey. Printed by BML.
- Punching:** Sport Ident & SIAC enabled; No EOD SIAC hire available. Lost hired SI dibber cost £30.00

- Starts:** 1000 – 1230 hrs; the Start is 800m from parking/assembly area. **Course Close:** 1430 hrs

- Safety Eqpt:** **All competitors must carry a whistle.** (Available for purchase (£1) at Registration).
- Dress:** Full leg and upper arm cover is mandatory; that means no shorts or vests.
- Costs:** The cost per runner will be £25.00, £11.00 for the night event and £14.00 for the day event.
- Officials:** **SRO** Lt Col Mawer AAC, **Organiser** Maj R Barrett RLC, **Asst Organiser** Mr Steve McKinley SN, **Planner** Mr Paul Fox SN, **Controller** Charles Bromley Gardner BAOC.
- Facilities:** Tom's Catering, Compasspoint, Spectator run-in, prize-giving, toilets.
- Data:** The personal data you give at Registration will be used by the event organisers and their agents but only for the purpose of processing/publishing entries/results, conducting safety checks and as required by our insurers to validate our cover; and managed iaw GDPR.
- Insurance** For civilians participating in the SN Trophy, Public Liability Insurance is provided via your BOF membership; individuals are advised to have their own private accident insurance. This event is conducted iaw British Orienteering Rules and land booked iaw the AOA DIO Licence and JSP907. A detailed safety brief will be displayed at registration and in start lanes; by passing through the start process you will be deemed to have read it.
- Water** Water for refreshment provided in emergency only, bring your own and utilise the caterer.

All runners must download – even if they do not complete the course

Orienteering is an adventure sport; in the Army it is classed as Individual Military Training. Competitors are responsible for their own personal safety and for assessing their own abilities to complete the course.
