


## **MILITARY LEAGUE (SOUTH)**

**Travel Directions:** 

The event will be signed from the A350 to the Shearwater lake in the Longleat Forest, what3words – **resolved.atomic.classmate** (Grid ST 8544 4203), postcode BA12 8AE – you will be directed to an appropriate car park on arrival, see map. Parking maybe tight so car share if possible.



Terrain:

The area is predominantly mature forest, with a good network of tracks and mountain bike trails, and some thick foliage / brambles / forestry work. There is some steep ground and several areas of complexity.

Mapping:

This area has recently been remapped, having not been used for a number of years. The scale is 1:7500 overprinted on A3 waterproof paper. Loose control description will be provided at the start.
