<b>Travel Directions:</b>	Altcar Training Camp (ATC) via the main entrance (w3w basket.candles.campfires). The start location is a short distance north of ATC and is accessed via a marked and marshalled route. Limited parking is available at the civilian event centre at the Range High School, Formby. What3Words - shark.rear.joined GR: SD285059. Each team will be allowed one vehicle to park there for storing kit and transporting personnel.				
<b>Terrain:</b>	Formby Dunes is situated on the Sefton Coast between Liverpool and Southport, to the southwest of Woodvale RAF base. SD280056. A mixture of wooded and grassed dunes, generally very runnable, with complex contour detail.				
<b>Mapping:</b>	Scale 1:10,000 and 1:7,500. 2.5m contours. New updated map for the event based on LIDAR data. All courses printed on A4 waterproof paper. Control descriptions for all courses on the map and loose in the start lanes.
